- Progress towards the evaluation of Best Available Techniques (BAT) for flaring

As previously reported both Operators submitted interim reports by the required date.

SEPA will continue to work with ExxonMobil Chemical Limited and Shell UK Limited to provide advice and guidance if required, and will ensure any proposals are acceptable, appropriate and implement Best Available Techniques.

- Events since the last meeting

ExxonMobil have investigated and reported to SEPA on the flaring event that occurred on 26th February. Implementation of follow-up actions will be reviewed with ExxonMobil at a future inspection.

- Environmental Monitoring

SEPA is carrying out air quality monitoring in the vicinity of the Mossmorran complex.

Data is being collected and will be shared with the Committee, as soon as possible.
